TRAVEL REMINDERS

AIRPORT

- Students should expect to arrive at the Oscar Arnulfo Romero airport on January 4.

TRANSPORTATION

- Airport Pickup/Dropoff will be arranged once flights are confirmed. This is included in your program fee. A driver will be waiting for you with a sign that has your full name and NYU Wagner on it.
- We will take a coach bus to Chalatenango/San Ignacio. There will be a bilingual guide with us the entire time.
- Field assignments will have a bilingual driver and you will be transported by minivan.

MEALS

- Breakfast -- is included in your hotel room rate. You are more than welcome to eat elsewhere (on your own dime) if you would like to.
- Lunch -- packed lunches will be available on certain days and are listed as such. While we are in Chalatenango, there is not much within walking distance to eat.
