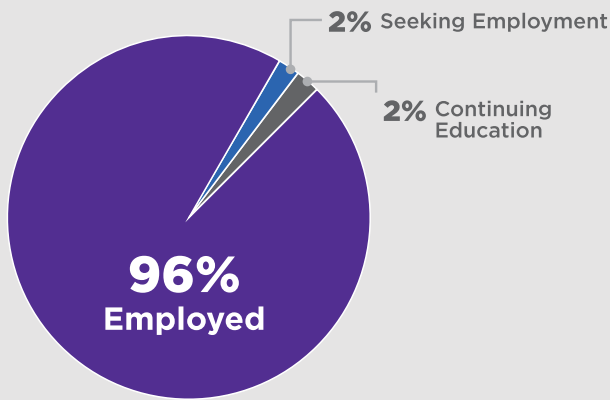


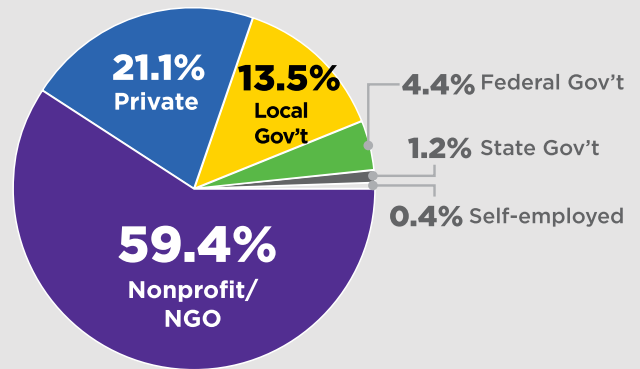
# EMPLOYMENT REPORT: 2017 GRADUATES

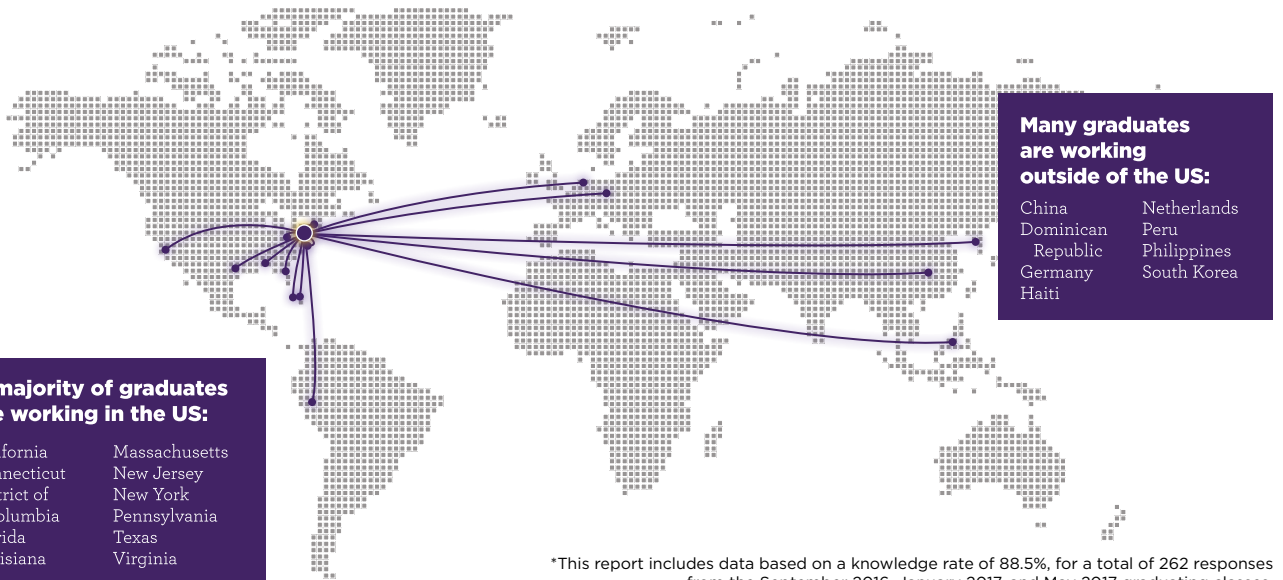
## WITHIN 10 MONTHS, 96% ARE EMPLOYED
